Thank you for your letter dated 12th October 2009 to Ruth Chapman. It has been passed to me as Communications Officer for the City Centre Infrastructure. I apologise for the delay in replying to you.

I appreciate the issues that you raise with regard to the recent changes to Churchill Way. The Council are very much aware of the situation and, as in previous years, are looking to lessen the impact of the Christmas retail rush with several measures.

The Council are engaging with South Wales Police to provide traffic wardens in the area who will be able to deal with any queuing vehicles efficiently and appropriately during peak times over the Christmas period.

In addition, new car park management signs are to be implemented shortly that will inform drivers when City Centre car parks are full and direct them to the next available car park. One of these management signs will be located at the junction of Station Terrace.

The Council is eager for this situation to be alleviated not only for the impact that it has on residents and businesses on Churchill Way, but also the impact that it could have on the buses that travel through the area and subsequent traffic.
