Dear Councillor Wakefield,

Re: "Mardi Gras" Event, Churchill Way – 1st & 2nd September.

I am attaching for your information a copy letter that I have this week sent to the leader of Cardiff County Council regarding the above.

I think it is fair to say that the event caused major inconvenience to the residents of Landmark Place and not only those closest to the event; the acoustics and predominantly glass facade of the adjacent Piazza and Helmont House ensured that there was an amplified echo effect toward the rear of Landmark Place as well.

(The stand-in concierge on duty at Landmark Place on the Saturday night claims to have received over a hundred calls about the noise prior to the 04:15am ending).

Whereas I appreciate that the event has now passed, I thought it would nevertheless still be worthwhile in bringing this issue to your attention, lest any further such events are mooted. I am not sure whether local councillors are routinely consulted as part of any presumed licensing process, but if you are then this will hopefully assist in informing any future decisions.
